

# 2019 Weibring Golf Camp @ ISU

## Overview

The Weibring Golf Club Junior Academy has developed an innovative golf program for juniors 4 – 16 years of age. The program will be administered by PGA Assistant Golf Professional Stacey Miller and several additional instructors. To ensure personal safety, focused attention, and quality of instruction during this camp, a ratio of 4:1 is implemented between junior golfers and instructors.

## Our Goal

Our goal with the program is to facilitate a fun atmosphere where learning can take place. We plan to cover golf etiquette, short game and full swing fundamentals, along with helping juniors transfer those skills onto the golf course. We also offer a fitness aspect which relates golf skill movements with other common athletic sports. Each session will be a four-day duration. The progression of the week is designed to allow each participant's golf skills to build off each day's lesson. Being able to enjoy the game of golf and have FUN is of most importance!
